

## LB1 - Unit 4 - Have you got a big family? | Leerstof Hoofdstuktoets

### Grammar summary

#### Prepositions of time: in, on

*My birthday is in April/September/May.*

*The exam is on Monday/Wednesday/Friday.*

*The school trip is in the summer/winter/spring/autumn.*

*The first day of school is on the third of September.*

- We gebruiken "in" bij maanden en seizoenen.

*The school show is **in** May. The exams are **in** the summer.*

- We gebruiken "on" bij dagen van de week en data.

*My birthday is **on** Saturday. My birthday is **on** the 24 th of June.*

#### Has got/Hasn't got

##### **Affirmative = bevestigende zinnen**

*He's got long hair.*

*She's got a nice smile.*

*It's got brown eyes.*

##### **Negative = ontkennende zinnen**

*He hasn't got curly hair.*

*She hasn't got blonde hair.*

*It hasn't got blue eyes.*

## **Questions and short answers = vragen en korte antwoorden**

*Has he got a beard?*

*Has she got wavy hair?*

*Has it got a big window?*

*Yes, he has./No, he hasn't.*

*Yes, she has./No, she hasn't.*

*Yes, it has./No, it hasn't.*

• We gebruiken "have got" als we het hebben over iemand z'n bezit en ook om iemand te beschrijven.

*She's **got** a daughter. (afgekort has got)*

*He's **got** brown hair. (afgekort has got)*

## **Common mistakes = veel gemaakte fouten**

*Have she got a big family? ✗*

*Has she got a big family? ✓*

## **Common mistakes= veelgemaakte fouten**

*I've got two childs. ✗*

*I've got two children. ✓*

*There are three persons here. ✗*

*There are three people here. ✓*

*Have got: I, you, we, you, they*

**Affirmative= bevestigende zinnen** Negative

*I've got two brothers.*

*You've got a big family.*

*We've got a cat.*

*They've got a big house.*

**Negative= ontkennende zinnen**

*I haven't got a sister.*

*You haven't got any posters.*

*We haven't got a dog.*

*They haven't got a red car.*

**Questions and Short answers= vragende zinnen en korte antw**

*Have you got a niece?*

*Have I got your pen?*

*Have we got a menu?*

*Have they got any cousins?*

*Yes, I have./No, I haven't.*

*Yes, you have./No, you haven't.*

*Yes, we have./No, we haven't.*

*Yes, they have./No, they haven't.*

- We gebruiken " *have got*" om over bezit te praten.

*They've got a daughter.*

*I've got a new bike.*

**Common mistakes**

*Have you got a computer? Yes, I've got. X*

*Have you got a computer. Yes, I have. ✓*
